A.O.C : Pessac - Léognan

Estates size : 63 ha - vineyard 42 - wood 21 ha

Production area : 38 ha

Soil : Clay gravels and sandy gravels with clay subsoil.

Grape varieties: Merlot noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec.

Planting density : 7 150 plants / ha

Farming: Biodynamic bovine compost amendments, shallow ploughing for correct management of grass cover.

Farming process: Herbal teas, decoctions, natural contact products and biodynamic preparations (Maria Thun, Horn Dung & Horn silica)

Harvest : Manuel by successive sorting.

Vinification: Gentle extraction in conical stainless steel tanks.

Ageing : 30 hl casks, 750l terracota amphoras, 18 hl concrete eggs.

Varietal blend: 53% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Cabernet Franc, 12% Merlot, et 8% Petit Verdot.

Degree : 13°

Production : 35 000 bottles

Certification: Ecocert & Biodyvin.
